1. 1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 The CET came into existence on 1 April 2015 when the Public Adult Learning Centres (PALCs) migrated from the Provincial Education Departments (PEDs) to the CET Colleges, resorting under the Department of Higher Education and Training (DHET). The mandate of the college is to provide quality and relevant education and training programmes for youth and adults to improve their livelihoods. The College, through the Community Learning Centres, offer programmes that will ensure that learners attain skills that will enable them to either find employment or establish their own enterprises.
- 1.2 The College is situated in KwaZulu-Natal Province, South Africa. Governance of the College rests with the Council subject to the relevant statutes and policies. 6. EVALUATION CRITERIA

Bidders will be evaluated based on stage one (1) relating to functionality criteria and stage 2 preferential point system based on price and BBBEE score on 90/20 as per PPPFA. Any bidder failed to in phase one will be go through to second phase. Any failed bidder will be non-responsive.

- Background of experience providing similar services to similar suppliers (including CVs and qualifications for facilitators)
- Reference checks at similar suppliers to KZNCET College
- Company profile

Point system

Price point is 90 points and BBBEE score is 10 points
